
DIVE INTO HISTORY PYRAMIDS OF GIZA

THE DIY TRAVELLER

Letting employees book their own travel seems like a great idea. Freedom! Flexibility! What's not to love? In reality, it can get complicated fast.

From unintentional overspending to accidentally booking outside policy, this approach can lead to some tricky situations. Smith cautions, "Without proper guidelines, self-booking can quickly become a challenge for both travellers and the finance team."

If this is your preferred method, implement a user-friendly booking tool that incorporates your travel policy. And make sure everyone actually understands the rules.

THE TRADITIONAL TRAVEL AGENT

Using a regular travel agent for business trips is like using a map app that doesn't update in real time. They might not be fully equipped for the complexities of corporate travel.

While great for planning holidays, they often lack the specialised tools and knowledge required for effectively managing business travel. Think limited reporting capabilities and potential struggles with implementing corporate travel policies.

THE TRAVEL MANAGEMENT PROS

Travel Management Companies

(TMCs) like FCM specialise in corporate travel, and are armed with industry connections, advanced tech, and the ability to handle everything from simple bookings to travel emergencies.

But even experts need to be in sync with your company's needs. Smith notes, "A good TMC acts as a strategic partner in your business growth. They should understand your company culture, align with your goals, and make your travellers' lives easier."

THE AI APPROACH

Al is making its mark in travel management, promising streamlined bookings and personalised recommendations. Exciting stuff but it's not without its challenges. There's potential for errors and the risk of losing that human touch when unexpected issues arise (and they always will in travel).

Smith's perspective? "Al is a powerful tool, but it works best when combined with human expertise and oversight."


Each approach has its pros and cons. The key is understanding the risks, preparing for potential issues, and having a clear, well-communicated travel policy.

"Regardless of your chosen method, success comes down to clear communication, regular programme reviews, and balancing costefficiency with traveller satisfaction," concludes Smith. ⁽¹⁾

between their regular tasks. Sounds efficient, right? Well, not exactly.

From booking non-refundable flights on the wrong day to choosing less-thanideal hotels, the potential for hiccups is real. Smith says: "Oversights happen when the company's travel needs aren't someone's primary focus. These aren't just inconveniences – they can impact business outcomes and eat into your profits, too."

 he sight of a champagne bottle being opened with a swift slice of a sword is

a grand gesture that exudes confidence and celebration. For those who have successfully sabered a bottle, it's an accomplishment tied to a time-honored tradition. For others, the idea provokes a mix of excitement and anxiety. But what exactly is sabering, and where did this practice originate? And how can you master it without risking shards of glass in your drink? This guide explores the history and art of sabering, offering a step-bystep method to ensure your success.

A HISTORICAL GESTURE ROOTED IN VICTORY


The practice of sabering dates back to the Napoleonic era, steeped in legend. According to popular accounts, we owe this dramatic gesture to Napoleon Bonaparte and his army of Hussars. The Hussars, a dashing group of light cavalry soldiers known for their bravery, were said to celebrate victories by slicing the tops off champagne bottles with their sabres.

Some stories even suggest that these soldiers used their sabering skills to charm Madame Clicquot, the widow who famously took over her husband's Champagne business and revolutionized the industry. Whether fact or fiction, these tales add a sense of romance and daring to sabering, making it a symbol of celebration and success.

THE MODERN-DAY SABRAGE

Today, sabering remains a celebrated tradition, especially in France where it is honored by the Confrérie du Sabre d'Or, or the Brotherhood of the Golden Sword. This formal group takes the art of sabrage seriously, with members ceremoniously opening bottles of champagne with their sabres while donning traditional attire.

While the Hussars and their battlefield



celebrations are long gone, sabering has found a place in modern festivities, from weddings to New Year's Eve parties, captivating onlookers with its blend of elegance and bravado.

MASTERING THE SABRAGE TECHNIQUE

If you're eager to try sabering yourself, it's important to approach the

technique with both respect and caution. Here's how to do it right:

1. Choose Your Bottle Wisely

Select a bottle of Champagne or locally produced Cap Classique for best results. These have the ideal level of pressure for sabering. Cava and Prosecco, while delightful, generally have less internal pressure and are less effective for this technique.



2. Select Your Weapon

A sharp kitchen knife can work just as well as a traditional sabre, provided it has a good weight and sturdy blade. Ensure whatever you use is sharp enough.

3. Chill the Bottle

Chill the bottle thoroughly by placing it in the freezer or submerging the neck in a bucket of ice for 15-20 minutes. A well-chilled bottle breaks more cleanly and reduces the amount of bubbly lost upon impact.

4. Prepare the Bottle

Remove the foil and wire cage that secures the cork. Locate the seam of the bottle - a subtle line running vertically from top to bottom.

5. Position Yourself and the Bottle

Hold the bottle at a 30-45 degree angle, ensuring the neck points away from you and anyone nearby. Place your thumb



in the punt (the indent at the bottom) and extend your forefingers along the neck. Avoid wrapping your entire hand around the bottle's neck to prevent injury.

6. The Sabering Motion

Rest the blade flat against the bottle's seam and run it gently along the seam a few times. When ready, pull the blade back toward your body, apply pressure, and then swiftly thrust it along the seam toward the bottle's lip. A confident flick of the wrist should do the trick.

7. Check and Serve

If executed correctly, the neck should snap off cleanly, taking the cork with it. Before pouring, inspect the bottle for any glass shards. Once satisfied, pour the champagne and enjoy your success.

CELEBRATING TRADITION

Sabering is more than just a party trick; it's a ritual connecting us with history and the celebratory spirit of past generations. Whether marking a milestone or adding drama to a gathering, mastering sabrage is sure to impress and delight. With the right preparation and practice, you can make sabering part of your champagne experience. After all, as Napoleon Bonaparte said, "Champagne! In victory, one deserves it, and in defeat, one needs it!"

Ardmore's distinctive blend of traditional African motifs with contemporary influences captivated audiences worldwide, earning them a reputation for whimsical and intricate designs inspired by African wildlife and folklore.

In 2010, Fée's children Jonathan, Catherine and Megan expanded Ardmore's horizons by venturing into the realm of fabric design, giving rise to Ardmore Home, and ultimately Ardmore Fashion several years later. By translating their iconic ceramic designs onto silk. linen and cotton, the brand found new avenues for creative expression, garnering attention from renowned designers and artists. This expansion further solidified the brand's presence in the luxury market, heralding collaborations with prestigious names like Hermès.



With a team of over 70 artists, Ardmore remains committed to economic empowerment and the preservation of African artistic traditions. 
HOW DO YOU DEFINE STYLE?



COUNTING THE COST **OF ROAMING**

Avoiding Expensive Roaming Costs While Travelling

Where and how to access eSIMs that will save you an arm and a leg, and how to decide on the right service provider and package for your needs

> hanks to the rise of embedded subscriber identity module (eSIM) technology, travellers making the most

> of the upcoming mid-year holidays will no longer need to factor expensive international roaming charges into their holiday budgets.

Unlike physical SIM cards, eSIMs are built into mobile devices and offer users multiple lines that can be switched at their convenience. Because the embedded SIM can be remotely programmed, travellers visiting foreign countries can still use their same number but on a different profile loaded with data, talk time and other mobile services.

GLOBAL REACH

This technology's uptake has been remarkable, particularly in North America and Western Europe. Tens of thousands of sports lovers are expected to descend on Paris for the Olympics in July and August, and its popularity is expected to surge even further. In the international travel space alone, the global number of eSIM users will increase from 40 million this year to 215 million in 2028, according to findings released by research giant Juniper in April.

Juniper also forecasts that the global eSIM market will grow from R19.16 billion in 2024 to almost R167 billion in four years. These figures are based mainly on the fact that nearly 400 mobile service providers have launched these services for smartphones across 116 countries since June last year.

"One of the biggest draws of eSIMs for travellers is avoiding expensive international roaming charges from their home carrier," says Mark Collie, Director at global eSIM service provider KnowRoaming.

"Frequent travellers also need seamless global coverage without having to purchase multiple local SIM cards in each country, so they look for options that cover multiple travel destinations under one plan."

Collie makes the critical point that travellers also want the flexibility to keep their primary SIM in their device

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to receive incoming calls and SMSes, ensuring they remain reachable on their regular number while utilising an eSIM for data services.

He advises that customers always look for established brands in the eSIM space, positive user reviews, and excellent customer support channels when selecting an eSIM provider.

FIND YOUR ESIM

Various platforms offer different methods for purchasing and activating an eSIM. Some facilitate the process through their website, while others provide a dedicated app.

Irrespective of the platform, the digital purchasing flow is straightforward. Users click on an install link or button, scan a QR code, or enter a provided activation code, and follow the on-screen prompts to complete the setup process. From there, it's simply a matter of switching the mobile data connection to the new eSIM profile and enabling data roaming for that particular channel.

Considering that costs tend to skyrocket in cities hosting events like the Olympics, travellers must compare the pricing of different packages against their usage requirements. Internet browsing, social media and streaming services should all be considered.

Packages such as those offered by KnowRoaming do offer top-up options as well.

For Collie, one of the most critical aspects is that an eSIM provides a highquality, low-latency connection and can share data via a hotspot.

He says the eSIM journey should be as simple as possible, though he does offer a few handy tips that travellers would do well to follow. These include:

- Purchase the eSIM in advance to avoid last-minute rushing.
- Carry a fully charged power bank when activating the eSIM upon arrival at a destination (in case the phone's battery is low from travelling).
- If eSIM activation involves QR codes, these should be saved into the phone or cloud storage for easy access.
- Users should familiarise themselves with the activation steps specific to the eSIM provider and device.
- Monitor data usage, mainly if the plan has limited data.
- Download the eSIM provider's mobile application or log in to its website to view balances and topup requirements.

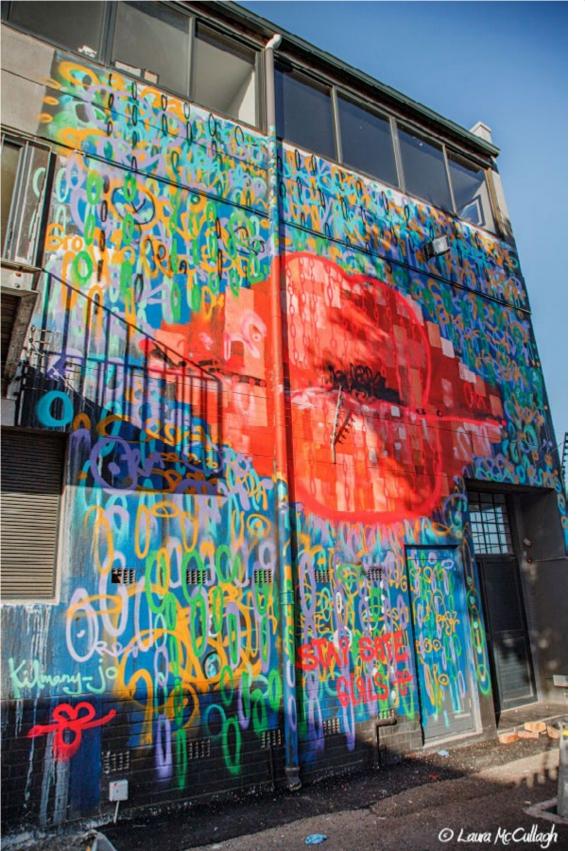

Her mural connects these experiences, celebrating the sense of belonging and togetherness that defines community.

KILMANY-JO LIVERSAGE: "KISS THE WORLD AND THE WORLD WILL KISS YOU BACK"

Kilmany-Jo crafts portraits that

blur the lines between fine art and graffiti. Her use of urban art language refreshes and challenges traditional painting conventions. Inspired by renaissance-era portraiture, her work also nods to digitized mass production and a futuristic world of perfect female cyborgs. 
